When it was torn into scraps, the square made itself into a garden.


Cut out this square and tear it into scraps. What can you make with the pieces?








What can you make with a square?

When it was shattered, the square made itself into a bridge.


Cut out this square and cut it into shards, so it looks as though it was shattered. What can you make with the pieces?








What can you make with a square?
